









We'd love to hear about them and possibly create opportunities to view these treasures once again. Contact the office or speak with Pastor.

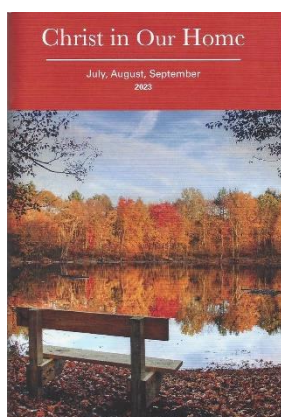
